

10 ATTENTION GETTERS



Change your voice (robotic voice, whisper, speak with an accent, sing...)

Agree on a class 'Call-and-Response'
For Example:

You say, "Hocus pocus..." Students respond, "Everybody focus!"



Clap simple patterns and have students repeat back.

Use props that correspond with lesson content.



Underline or put a colorful frame around important information.

Tell a relevant story from your childhood.



Use movie clips or short videos to supplement lesson content.

Play games to review (Jeopardy, Pictionary, Kahoot).



Take 1-minute movement/stretch breaks.

Use simple drawings to illustrate vocabulary words and/or concepts.
